
Message from Metro's PWB Committee Council Chair Linda Garvey:

Metro's PWB celebrated the week by paying tribute to our Metro PWB Council Members and by introducing everyone to their **new 2025 Sponsorship/Scholarship Program**. I have been working with Julie Stilo of Stilo Disposal, we are co-chairs working this new and exciting **Sponsorship/Scholarship Program**. As an **NAHB PWB 2023 Small Council of the Year Award** recipients, we thought what a better way to celebrate **PWB Week** by rolling out the program. The details are below:

Metro's PWB has formally established the "2025 Sponsorship Program" (Effective January 1 through December 31, 2025) program that contributes toward PWB events and, most importantly, a "Metro PWB 2025 Scholarship Award." We want to establish this scholarship for young Vo-Tech/high school female who will continue their education in the construction and building industry. This scholarship will be offered to students within the six (6) counties we serve - Essex, Hunterdon, Morris, Somerset, Union, and Warren. The program will be split 50/50; 50% of the sponsorship funds will go toward the Scholarship Program, and the other 50% will go toward other Metro PWB initiatives/events. We will also have a donation box at ALL our events, which we will be collecting from not only Metro members but also any guests who attend our events. 100% of funds collected at our events will go toward the Scholarship Program.
